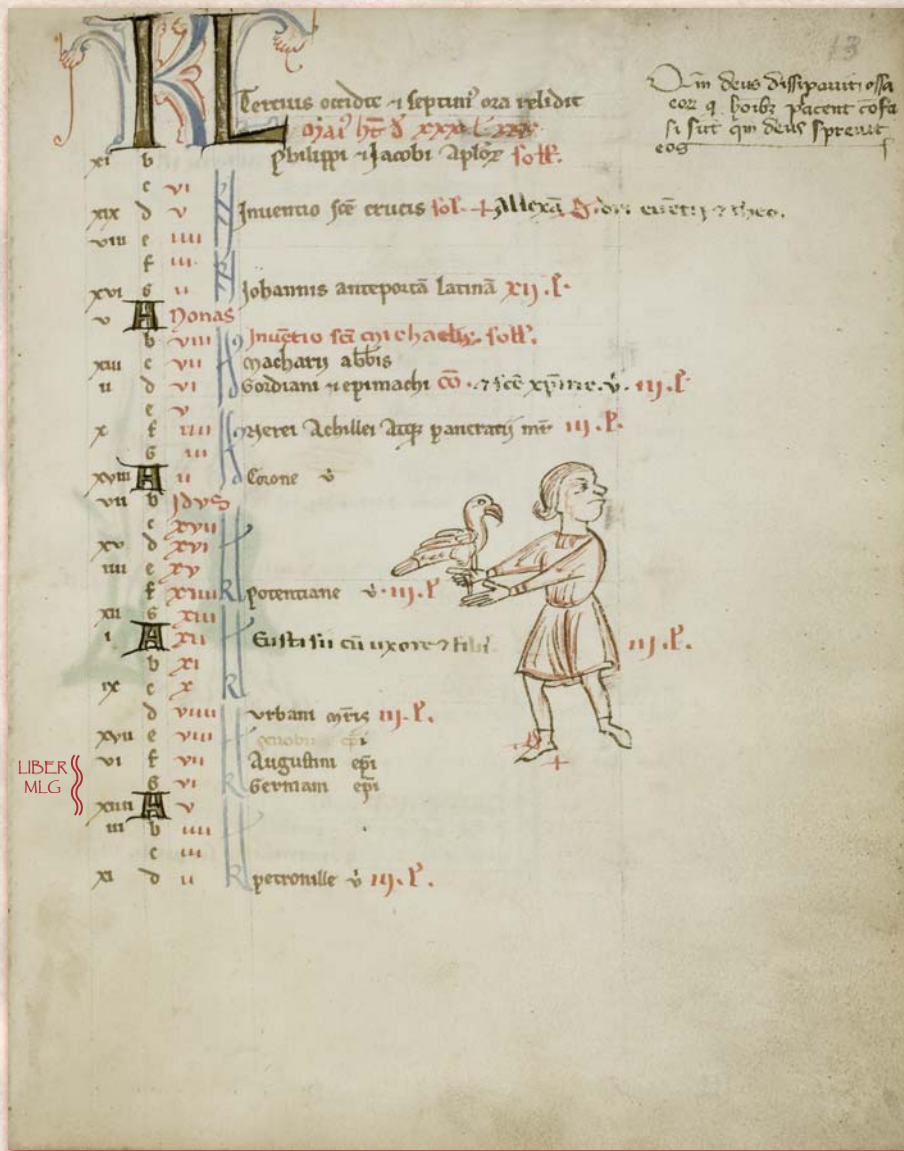




4th Conference of LIBER Manuscript Librarians Group “Meeting with manuscripts, today and tomorrow” Rome, 26 - 28 May 2010
